#### **LASTING CHANGE**



88% of children in our Early Development and School Readiness programs improved their academic skills.



**91%** of clients treated in our Pediatric Urgent Care program were diverted from visiting the hospital emergency department.



96% of high school seniors (25 of 26) earned the credits necessary for graduation.



95% of all clients were satisfied with the services they received.

It is well documented that our clients make significant improvement when they are with us. Our 12-month longitudinal study, started in 2009, shows that not only do clients sustain those gains, they continue to improve.


47% had a family member who was depressed or mentally ill for a long time.

44% had a family member or someone very close to them who died unexpectedly.

42% had a family member who was put in jail, or prison, or taken away by the police.

**41%** were completely separated from their parent(s) for a long time; in foster care, living far apart, or never seeing the parent again.

37% were threatened or harassed by a bully (someone outside of his/her family).
