- Programs deliver a balance of bolstering resilience and supporting mastery of essential age-appropriate skills



Therapists and Care Coordinators support youth to facilitate mental, emotional, social, and even physical wellness

- Dedicated providers at 83 partner schools and 3 health clinics in the region
- Actively present in the school-day to reduce barriers to clients' success and progress
- Offer multiple individualized modalities to address school, home, and community-related difficulties

Pediatric Mental Health Urgent Care offers support to families of youth navigating mental health crises

- 96% of children were diverted from a hospital emergency department
- 75% of children and 80% of parents served reported feeling less stress after their visit
- A total of 138 children and their families were offered a safe environment and assistance



Recruitment and retention practices ensure we meet the needs of the children and families in our region

- Almost 4,000 referrals received this year and 200,000 + hours of service delivery
- Hosted the 3rd successful Staff Wellness Day for behavioral health providers to prioritize their own self-care needs
- Best Point has an 80% provider retention rate

## WHO WE PROUDLY SERVE


of children in our care experienced one or more traumatic events **51%** had a family member who was depressed or mentally ill for a long time.

47% had a family member or someone very close to them who died unexpectedly.

44% had a family member who was put in jail, or prison, or taken away by the police.

45% were separated from their parent(s) for a long time (foster care, living apart, etc.)

41% were threatened or harassed by a bully (someone outside of his/her family).
